



Obilic Club Resolution 22 August 2004.

Training

- Trainings run by training co-ordinator^ and not coach. Training co-ordinator to discuss training format with senior players prior to training.
- Trainings to be more upbeat. Not to be bogged down with philosophies and plays. Trainings will be reactionary to competition. Try and fix current game play faults at trainings.
- Trainings are to be more based on social side i.e. everyone is to get a fair go.
- Trainings are not to be focused on any individuals or single groups. Training is club based not specific team based.
- Drills are done on a voluntary basis. If individual choses to only scrimmage that is fine. If individual choses to avoid fitness circuit that is also fine. This is acceptable as some players are unable to attend training.

Game

- Each senior team dedicated team captain* not coach.
- Captains role to pick starting 5 and "if" necessary make final decision on team discussions at time outs.
- During timeouts and team discussions all players to listen/participate/focus. All team members should try and implement what is discussed.
- It is players's responsibility to do their fair share of duty during the season. A Duty Roster will be drawn up and distributed to each team member. If the player can not attend a rostered duty session it is up to that player to organize a replacement for that session, and to make up for it at a latter rostered duty.

Code of Conduct

- Technical Fouls will invoke a \$20 fine payable to the club within 7days or the offending player will be suspended from play (unless mitigating circumstances).
- Each player/member is to treat every other player/member in the club with respect.
- No player in the club is to be physically threatened or abused. Similarly, extreme verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Any player involved in physically threatening another Obilic player will face an elected 3 member disciplinary committee.

- The elected disciplinary committee has the power to suspend and even terminate a player deemed in breach of the “Code of Conduct”. The highest ranked non-involved committee member will organise disciplinary committee.
- Must pay registration fees upfront by the first week of start of the competition.
- No players to play in someone else’s name (unless mitigating circumstances - avoid forfeit/club fine etc).
- Every player must pay training fees if you enter the training court, regardless of how much time is spent training at that session.
- Every team/club member is required to pay the annual \$10 membership fee and to receive an Obilic drink bottle once they have paid.
