Meeting opened at 2010.

1. President's report

- Very pleased that our court at PCYC has new Basketball Rings. The installation was paid for by Obilic and thanks to Zoran and Milos Salipur and Nemanja Gavrilovic for installing the Rings.
- Project Re-equip was a co-op grant with the Federal Gov't allowing the club to replenish Basketball Equipment.
- Uniforms and new Obilic accessories (shirts/hoodies) look great and thanks to Zoran, Milos and Melissa Salipur for facilitating this.
- Very pleased that 3 men's teams are entrenched now, with more options for senior players.
- Great that we continue supporting the community, such as Tesla Expo and Orphanage in Belgrade.
- Attendance of established players at Sunday's training is still low but improving
- Due to cash flow issues in last 6 months, Coaches have not been remunerated for time lost and personal costs for Coaching and this needs to be addressed with immediate effect.

2. Treasurer's report

- Melissa reported \$XXXXX.XX in the account as at 31 March 2018.
- Agreed that \$60 card payment device (Square) would be procured to allow people to pay any outstanding fees by Card. Vanja agreed to procure on behalf of the club.

3. Elections – President, Vice President, Treasurer, Marketing, Events Coordinator, Equipment, Juniors' Manager, Public Affairs Manager

- President (Stevan Sipka – unopposed), VP (Zoran Salipur – unopposed), Treasurer (Melissa Salipur – unopposed), Equipment Manager (Zoran Salipur), Junior

Development (Milos Salipur), Public Affairs (Alex Glumac), Competition Coordinator (Nemanja Kovacina elected to this position)

4. Registration as KK Obilic Incorporated

- Obilic has an ABN since Mar '16 and is registered with NSW Fair Trading since 15 Mar '01.
- A12 forms to be submitted by Melissa and Stevan at the soonest.

5. Obilic Senior Mens/Ladies Teams update

- Agreed that the Royals should adopt the Blue Strip and keep white for Derby
- Knights are doing well and nice to have Maric in the team.
- Warriors are improving all the time and have mix of experienced and young players.
- It was stated that we may want to think about a 4th Men's team on another evening or unisex team.
- Obilic Ladies won Div 4 and now play in Div 3 and are competitive. The team has 9 players and all is positive with this team.
- Agreed that Bankstown Summer comp should have a team selected for DMC18. Limit team to 8 players, with other 2 playing for other team.
- Court fee payments for senior teams are handled by each team.

6. Obilic Junior Boys/Girls Teams update

- u/14 boys' team is very young team and after initial struggle now has 7 players. Jerseys for some players are on order and should arrive in 4 weeks.
- u/16 boys' team is a new team and has 7 players. All have jerseys.
- u/18 boys' team is a good team and now has 7 players.
- u/18 girls' team is majority under age. They are competitive and have 8 players. Some woman's jerseys need to be collected from players that have left the club.
- u/22 boys are still playing and are self-sustained with Slavisa as team captain.
- All junior players (excl. u/22) need to pay \$150 for the Winter '18 comp to cover court fees.

7. Training Times/Concept/Fees/Coaches/Remuneration for Coaches

- Training times and fees remain unchanged.
- Nemanja Kovacina has agreed to coach u/14 and u/16 boys during Bankstown Summer comp to give Zoran a rest.
- Coaches to be remunerated. This need to be top priority going forward.

8. Changes at PCYC and need for all Obilic to be registered

- All players on Thursday (even seniors) must enter through front as back doors of Basketball Court must be closed.
- All Obilic players must be PCYC members.

9. NSW Active Kids update – KK Obilic as a provider for \$100 voucher

- Still working on this with a few administrative requirements requested by Active NSW.

10. Club Budget for FY18/19

- Vanja and Melissa have stated that they will try and work on this concept.

11. DMC 2018 – Adelaide

- Provisional dates are 22-24Dec for tournament play with opening ceremony on 21Dec. This needs to be confirmed as organisers are still awaiting Stadium confirmation.
- Stevan has made initial request to Airline for quote on regular and charter flight basis.

12. Obilic Cup 3 on 3 Competition – Concept & When

- Proposed date is Sunday 21Oct. Will need to secure date with PCYC management. Could be adjusted subject to Master's Games in Alice Springs.

13. Fundraiser for Belgrade Orphanage – City2Surf 2018 & future participation

- Likely that 2018 will be final City2Surf, as entry costs are getting very steep.
- Will look at other opportunities to have fundraisers, such as Dinner.

14. Sponsorships inward and outward

- Club members should approach employers for sponsorship. Royals need new set of jerseys, and this could be a corporate sponsorship opportunity.

15. Club Public Liability Insurance update

- Due to now being venue users at PCYC, Obilic had to take out Public Liability Insurance. This cost will need to be passed onto members.

16. Web-site/Social Media report

- It's clear that Milan isn't able to dedicate much time to updating the web-site. The AGM recognizes and thanks Milan for his amazing contribution to the club in the past.
- It was suggested that Aleks Kuzmanovic consider taking over the web-site function.
- Alex Glumac is doing a good job on FB, but members need to feed him more information for posts.

17. Obilic Club Memberships & Audit (Annual Fee for FY18/19)

- To cover cost of Public Liability, all Obilic members need to pay membership fee by 30Jun18. The fee for seniors is \$20 and juniors (u/18) is \$10.

18. Social Activities/Responsibilities

- Myuna Bay was a great success but it was agreed due to higher DMC costs, that Obilic wouldn't look at a Myuna Bay camp this year.
- Bowling Evening was successful and will look to have another evening later in the year.
- Nemanja stated that some senior Obilic players would be heading to the snow fields this ski season and they would be open to other members joining them

19. Obilic 20-year anniversary celebration in Feb '19

- Agreed to have a celebration style dinner in Feb '19.
- Nemanja would look at quote for Harbour Cruise as 1st option.

20. Alice Springs Masters (Dejan Bogic)

- Dejan presented information about the Master's Games between 13-20 Oct '18. The cost will be likely \$1,200 and he'll look for interested participants within the club.

21. Other Items

- Melissa proposed Obilic consider fundraising for DMC18 subsidy via Bonnyrigg Bunning BBQ option. It was agreed that Obilic should try and secure a date and create a roster for people to volunteer on the day
- Milos suggested that the club consider Basketball Tour of Serbia in 2020. Milos will socialize the idea and see if there is interest within the club.
- Milos also informed us of a project at Bonnyrigg Sports Club related to the construction of an Outdoor Basketball court. Obviously, a project of this nature is in the best interest of Obilic and the Serbian Community Basketball Fraternity.
