Brisbane 2019 TOURNAMENT RULES



General

* \$0 entry fee into the stadium for all spectators. No entry fee for players or Coaches.

* Any unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated, and may lead to Disqualification from the tournament.

* If any player receives 2 technical fouls in a single game, they will Automatically incur a one-match suspension, commencing the next game.

* All participating players must be registered on the team nomination form. **No Unregistered players are allowed to play for any team.**
(Special consideration may be granted to a team in the case of an injury or other unforeseen circumstance)

* **Players can only register on one team form per division.**
Players registered for a specific division cannot play games for another division.
Junior players will be allowed to help higher division team in their club.
Junior players can also be nominated to play in either of the senior men's (div1 or div2) or women's competitions.

* All teams will have to perform bench duty during the tournament. One representative from each team will need to assist in doing score bench during their team's game. Failure to fulfil duty requirement will result in a loss of 3 competition points.

* Rules and interpretations of rules will be at the sole discretion of the tournament rules administrators, Pavle Krkeljas and Ivan Ninkovic

Points and Classification System

Points System

Result	Points Awarded
Win	+3
Draw	+2
Loss	+1
Game or Duty Forfeit	-3

The following classification procedure is based on the official FIBA basketball rules of 2010.

a) If there are two teams in the classification with equal points, the result(s) of the Game(s) between the two teams involved will be used to determine the placing.

b) If the points and the goal average in the games between the two teams are still the same, the classification will be determined by the goal average of all the games played in the group by each team.

c) If more than two teams are equal in the placing, a second classification will be Established, taking into account only the results of the games between the teams

that are tied.

d) If there are still teams tied after the second classification, then goal average will be used to determine the placing, taking into account only the results of the games between the teams still tied.

e) If there are still teams tied, the placing will be determined using the goal average From the results of all their games played in the group.

Game Timing

- a) All games (excluding Men's Division 1 Grand Final): 4 x 10 min Quarters with the last 2 minutes of each quarter to be fully timed.
- b) Time-out , Each time-out shall last 1 minute
- c) 1 time-outs during the first half, • 2 time-outs during the second half. Clock will stop during all time outs so teams cannot run out the clock. Unused time outs from the first half cannot be carried over into the second half • 1 time-out during each extra period.

During the game if the team is holding the ball longer than 30 seconds referee has an authority to warn and count down the 10 last seconds.

b) Men's Division 1 Grand Final: 4 x 10 minute fully timed quarters: Each team is eligible to use 2 x 1 minute timeouts in the first Half and 3 x 1 minute time outs in second half. Any unused time outs from the first half will not be carried over to the second half. 1 min quarter time breaks, 3 minute half time break. Clock will stop on all whistles.

c) A match will be forfeited if a team does not have the minimum of 4 players, on court ready to play within 5 minutes of the game clock starting. Offending team will be penalised 2 points for every minute they are late until the minimum number of players take the court or the 5 minutes are up. The clock will not be stopped or be reset.

d) Should a team forfeit, their opponents will be awarded a 20 to 0 point victory and 3 competition points. The offending team will lose 3 competition points.

Tied games

The following rules will apply to Semi Final and Grand Final games **only**:

a. All finals (excluding Men's Div 1 Grand Final): In the case of a draw at the end of regulation time, a three minute overtime period will be played. Clock will be stopped during the last minute of play. Each team will receive 1 x 1 minute time out for the extra period. Unused time-outs from regulation time cannot be carried over to the extra time period. Team fouls will continue as if the overtime period is part of the second half.

b. Men's Division 1 Grand Final: In the case of a draw at the end of regulation time.

A 5 minute fully timed overtime period will be played. Each team will receive 1 x 1 minute time out for the extra period. Unused time-outs from regulation time cannot be carried over to the extra time period. Team fouls will continue as if the overtime period is part of the 4th quarter.

Personal and Team Fouls

a) Personal Fouls: A player will be disqualified from the game after five (5), personal and/or technical, fouls

b) Team Fouls: A team is in team foul penalty situation when it has committed 5 fouls in a single quarter. This will reset to 0 after each quarter.

Jump Ball Situations

- a) Alternating possession to be used rather than a jump ball.

Team Nominations and Eligibility

- a) U/18's competition means 18 years of age or under. This means player must still be 18 or under at the conclusion of the year (December 31 2019) e.g.
- b) U18 needs to be born in the year 2001 or later.
- c) U/16's competition means 16 years of age or under. This means player must still be 16 or under at the conclusion of the year (December 31 2019) e.g. U16 needs to be born in the year 2003 or later.
- d) U/14's e.g. U14 needs to be born in the year 2005 or later and U/12's e.g. U12 needs to be born in the year 2007 or later.
- e) All junior players must provide identification of age during the tournament. Prior to every junior game, a Tournament Official will check identification.
- f) All nomination forms and team entry fees must be received no later than 6th of December 2019. (Absolutely no team entries after this date unless you have been granted special approval).
- g) Junior team entry fee: \$150 (U12's / U14's / U16's / U18's boys & Girls)
- h) Senior Women team entry fee: \$300 (Div 1 & 2 Women)
- i) Senior Men team entry fee: \$300 (Div 1 & 2 Mens)
- j) Entry forms without receipt (proof) of payment will not be accepted.

Coaches must sign all nomination forms as acknowledgement of the above stated rules and conditions of tournament. Unsigned forms will not be accepted.
